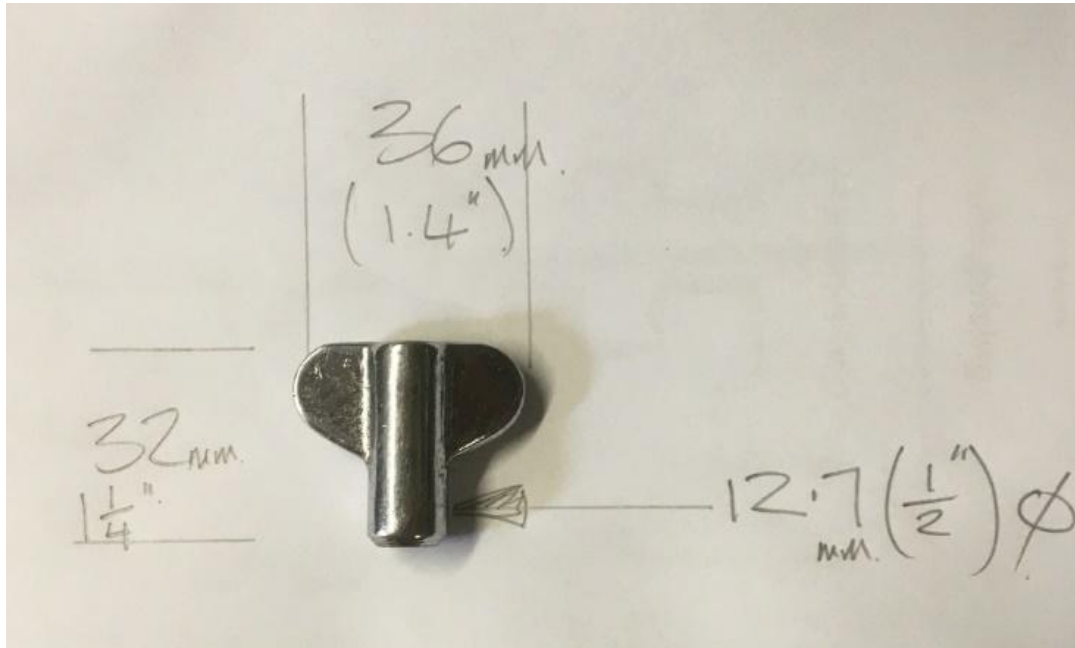


Forgive me if I'm repeating what's gone before on the DHMC hardtop wing nuts, below is a picture of an original nut used, these appear to have been cast in brass as the split line from the mould is still evident, just for reference I've shown the main dimensions. A detail is the chamfered end allowing the nut to centre itself on the bracket when tightened. It has been through tapped to 5/16" UNF thread, the nut has been chromed.



I have modified some wing nuts available from Wixroyd for a colleague to do the same job. I got these from www.wixroyd.com their part number [37420.W0010](http://www.wixroyd.com) these come with a 6mm blind tapped thread, this can be drilled through and tapped either to suit 5/16" UNF or 8mm. The 'barrel' diameter is 13mm almost the same as the original DHMC nuts. These nuts are made from stainless steel and are beautifully finished and very strong. A washer between the wing nut and the locating bracket stops the nut being able to pull up into the bracket.
